Enrolling is Simple...

The Success X Three program offers financial help to residents who are committed to improving their education. Enrolling requires the following steps:

- 1) Complete Success X Three Application
- 2) Apply to school of your choice (Complete FAFSA if needed)
- 3) Complete Life Skills class & Career Assessment
- 4) Sign up for Rock River Training Funds Orientation

Application deadlines are April 15 and October 15

The Success X Three Coordinator will be the point of contact to address resident questions or concerns throughout enrollment.

A history of Success.

Since its inception, the Success X Three program has provided many residents with the means to achieve a higher education.

Currently:

- 2 enrollees are pursuing four year degrees
- 6 enrollees are pursuing two year degrees
- 2 enrollees are pursuing one year degrees
- 11 have earned certifications in various fields
- 10 are in process of earning certifications

And 10 have found employment!
